

### ORTHODONTIC TREATMENT FOR CHILDREN AND EARLY INTERVENTION ORTHODONTICS

As parents, we aspire to provide our children with the best opportunities and make the transition into adulthood as smooth as possible. By giving your child a healthy beautiful smile you enhance their confidence and self-esteem.

Not all children require orthodontic treatment but early assessment and intervention can reduce treatment time and expense. Early treatment may also eliminate the need for fixed braces by the time your child reaches high school years. At Brunswick Dental Group, we recommend that parents schedule an assessment appointment



around age 7 or 8, following the emergence of your child's first adult molar teeth. This allows our team of dedicated dentists to check for



any signs of development irregularities and inform parents of the options available to them.



### ADOLESCENT ORTHODONTICS

Teenagers usually begin orthodontic treatment following the eruption of adult teeth, between 11 and 13. By exerting constant light pressure, corrective appliances will gradually move the teeth to the desired position. This treatment may involve several phases and various appliances designed to achieve optimum results. Depending on your child's specific needs, treatment varies from 6 to 24 months, during which our dedicated dentists will constantly monitor and explain your child's progress and oral health.

Being conscious of teenagers needs and demands, our dentists are aware of the aesthetic issues regarding orthodontic treatment and at Brunswick Dental Group, we use the latest appliances available today. Advancements mean that modern braces are not as bulky or unattractive as their predecessors.



### ORTHODONTICS FOR ADULTS

- To resolve muscle/joint tension and pain associated with malocclusion (unbalanced bite)
